

The application and selection process of the EVSS 2016



Thank you for your interest in the EVSS! If you'd like to apply, here is all you need to know about the application and selection process.

Who can apply for the EVSS?

Veterinary students from any country and any year of study may apply for the EVSS. The EVSS is aimed at European veterinary students, however Europe is not a very well-defined concept. If any definition of Europe applies to you, or you expect you will work in Europe later in your career, or you're just very interested in the state of veterinary medicine in Europe, please apply!

The EVSS is an event of the International Veterinary Students Association (IVSA), however it is not mandatory to be an IVSA member to apply for the EVSS. We do recommend becoming involved in IVSA, it's a wonderful experience! Look on www.ivsa.org for more information.

How do I apply for the EVSS?

From 21 March until 30 April, you can apply for the EVSS by filling out a Google form. We will post the link to the form on our website, <http://www.ivsa.nl/index.php/en/evss-2016>. Please note that filling in the form does not guarantee you a place as a delegate; there will be a selection process.

How does the selection process work?

Seeing as there are only 75 places available for the EVSS, we will select the most suitable delegates if the number of applications exceed the number of places. In the application form you will be asked to write a personal motivation letter. Selection will be primarily based on these motivation letters. Furthermore, we aim to get a diverse group of delegates from as many different countries and cultures as possible. However, a good motivation letter is the most important.

When will the results of the selection be announced?

The selection will take place in May; we will announce the results at the beginning of June by sending every applicant an e-mail with their personal result.
